Summary

The FLL, Jr program is a program for young students grades 2-3 to get introduced to science, technology, engineering and math concepts using Legos. This program is less structured than the FLL program offered for grades 4-8. This is the second season for the program at St. Leo's and we will again structure the season using the FIRST FLL, Jr program as explained at www.firstinspires.org/robotics/flljr.

The program will be run as a club with an expected 1 meeting week, and approx. 1 hour/meeting. Every attempt will be made to have regularly scheduled meeting dates and times, however as the teams are run by volunteers some variability in the weekly meeting schedule may occur, meetings may either be right after school or in the evening.

At this time, we only have enough parents volunteering to coach a small sized group. While we hope to be able to expand the program to include all students, additional parent volunteers will be required to allow for additional students. A meeting will be held in late August for all parents interested in volunteering to help determine how to organize the students and program.

We encourage all parents to consider volunteering. No prior experience in robotics or engineering is required. Assistance is available to help guide new volunteers to being successful in the program.
