CYO Sports is one component of a parish's comprehensive youth ministry program which enables the partnership of parents, coaches, priests, religious, teachers, and adult leaders to manage and support a sports program that allows youth to grow in their relationship with God and come to better understand themselves and the Catholic Faith.

Such a program:

- Employs healthy and enjoyable competition to promote the sharing of gospel values among athletes, parents and coaches.
- Assists parish leadership in nourishing the emotional, spiritual, social, and physical needs of young people.
- Encourages young people to appreciate the gifts that they possess, and challenges them to share these gifts with their community.
- Allows youth to witness the life of Christian Discipleship in their coaches and adult leaders.
- Encourages youth to become responsible members of their faith community.
- In keeping with the CYO Mission, each participant is encouraged to donate their time to service projects and to attend a team mass each session.

ST. LEO ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION Grievance Procedure

The appropriate forum for discussion of general matters relating to athletic association policies or procedures are the monthly meetings. These matters might include equipment, fundraising, uniforms, fields, teams, etc. In those instances when a problem arises regarding a specific coach or person, the following grievance procedure must be followed.

- 1) Parents should bring the matter to the attention of the head coach or person after a time period of 24 hours has elapsed. This is considered to be a cool off period to rethink what actions you want to talk about. After 24 hours, parents should make arrangements by phone to speak with the coach or person privately at an appropriate time and place without the presence of children.
- 2) If the matter cannot be resolved, parents should file a written grievance and submit it to the president of the athletic association <https://stleosathletics.com/wp-content/uploads/2013/09/SLAAGrievanceForm.pdf>. A meeting will then be arranged between the parents, coach, sport coordinator and officers of the athletic association. After the issues have been discussed, a vote will be taken to reach a decision. Voting members will include the members of the Grievance Committee.
