Join us for a day of exploring the vibrant stories of the people who made, and continue to make, Lancaster City a progressive cultural hub in Central Pennsylvania. We will start the morning of July 26th with a walking tour of downtown Lancaster that will highlight the accomplishments of many movers and shakers of Lancaster's past. Dr. Robert Frick, our tour guide, is a retired educator and an enthusiastic historian with awesome stories to tell. These stories will cast a whole new light on those who helped to make Lancaster what it is today - a dynamic city booming with business, art, theater, cuisine, and advocacy. This fun, interactive tour will introduce us to Lancastrians, some famous and some not, and forge a new appreciation for the city's past. After working up an appetite, we will explore Lancaster's culinary diversity by enjoying food from a local restaurant. After lunch, the stories continue as we hear from current leaders who continue to drive Lancaster's progressive legacy. As stories resonate with them, students will be encouraged to take photos, jot down notes or make sketches. Following some time to independently reflect, further explore, or create a "story" to share, we will return to IU13 on August 1st. That morning, participants will have the opportunity to share their interpretations and musings of Lancaster City using various artistic mediums including their own photography/digital images, poetry, drawings, writing, etc.
